NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, L. M. Nash of Fountain Summit,

in consideration of the sum of Ten and other Considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C. A. Nash of the above
place

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. A. Nash, All that lot, or parcel of land lying being and situate in Fairview Township County and State aforesaid containing Sixty-seven acres more or less, the same being a part of my old home place and both the following metes and bounds to-wit, found by lands of James M. Richardson Estate, Raburn Creek, James Farrow and myself, commencing at a stone James Richardson's corner running thence N. 72 3/4 E. 38.30 to center of Raburn Creek thence down said creek 25.90 to where spring branch intersects Raburn Creek thence up said branch to center of Spring thence S. 42 3/4 W. 175 to a black gum on bank of branch thence S. 55 1/4 W. 213.74 to a stone, thence N. 17 3/4 W. 22.00 to beginning corner.
