(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. A. Bull, his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land situate in Ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin at corner of W. D. Browning's lot and running thence along North Main Street N. 193.0 E. 103 feet to an iron pin at corner of North Main Street and Elford Street; thence along Elford Street N. 62.33 W. 148 feet to corner of lot no. 12 on Elford Street, thence along line of lot no. 2 S. 26.02 W. 101.9 feet to point in line of W. D. Browning's lot; thence along the line of W. D. Browning's lot S. 62.33 E. 159.7 feet to iron pin at the beginning corner being known and designated as Lot No. 1, according to a survey and plat of the estate of John H. McNeill made by R. E. 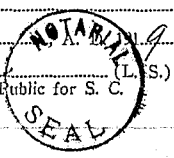
