NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That R. C. Evans of Greenville
County in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. L. Plumley of Greenville
County, in the state aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
W. L. Plumley, All that piece or parcel situated lying
and being in the County of Greenville State of S. C. on
both sides of South Packet River and bounded by lands
of J. H. Gosnell, W. L. Plumley, W. H. Plumley, and others,
running as follows, beginning on a hickory and
running thence S. 1 1/2, E. 30.30 to a stone, thence S. 45 E.
7.24 to a chestnut stump thence S. 25 1/2, E. 8.56 to a
stone, thence S. 1 1/2, W. 6.80 to a stake, thence N. 74 1/2 E.
8.00 to a stake, thence N. 20 1/2 E. 23.50 to a stone, thence
N. 55 E. 14.00 to a white oak near river, thence N.
33 W. 11.20 to a stone, thence N. 61 W. 16.50 to the
beginning corner, containing fifty acres more or
less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W. L. Plumley his
heirs and assigns, forever.

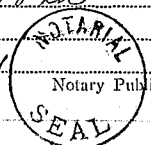
AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and

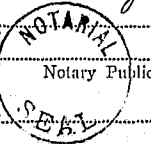
