NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. A. Satterfield  
in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred twenty and no/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J. H. Owens in the State aforesaid  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
J. H. Owens his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain  
piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in  
Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid contain-  
ing fifty nine and one half (59 1/2) acres more or less as  
more or less lying and being on the waters of Horse Creek, and  
known as tract No. 13 in sale of lands of Joseph W. Sullivan  
having the following metes and bounds as appears by  
plat of survey of James P. Willis of Oct. 2, 1901 to-wit:  
Commencing on west bank of Horse Creek on Bressley's  
line and running thence S. 65-1/2 N. 19.25 to stone 3 x 4 N.
