NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Elias Farah of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars and other good and valuable Considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Nannie Brown

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Nannie Brown:-
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the north side of John Street in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton, Aug. 1919. Commencing at a stake on the north side of John Street, corner of Annie Green property, thence along line of Annie Green N. 41.45 E. 187.7 feet to a stake on rear line; thence along rear line S. 47-43 E. 52 feet to a stake; thence along line of property of Elias Farah S. 41.45 W. 187.7 feet to a stake on the north side of John Street; thence along the north side of John Street N. 47-43 W. 52 feet to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Nannie Brown, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Nannie Brown, her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
