(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *J. T. Lindsey*

A certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County, in Glassy Mountains Township and State aforesaid, and bounded as follows. Beginning at a stone on S. O. Barnett line and run as follows: N. 63.37 W. 12.19 chains to a stone, thence S. 28.34 W. 12.13 chains to a large flat rock with E. J. Shanker corner, thence to a straight line 20 chains to beginning corner, containing eight acres more or less, and bounded by C. S. West, J. T. Lindsey and others.

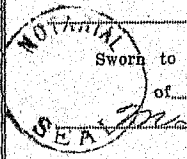
