(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. E. Lockhart all of and undivided interest

in and father's estate to wit Merdith Morgan deceased a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in Greenville County on branch waters of Laughlin Creek waters of North Carolin River Beginning on a dogwood cut down & run N 70° 21' 22" 38" W to a dogwood 3/4. Thence S. 37 1/2° 24' 21" 80" CH to a stone 3/4. Thence S 63 1/2° E 22.00 CH to a stone 3/4. Thence N 37 1/2° E 21.50 CH to the beginning corner containing fifty acres be the same more or less, be it known that six acres of this tract was deeded to the said Mrs. J. P.
