at and before the sealing of these presents by Geo. W. Johnson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Geo. W. Johnson, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying

and being in the Town of Travelers Rest, County and State aforesaid, on the east side of the Buncombe Road, and bounded by the Parsonage lot, lands of Mrs. Fannie Goodlett and the Love Estate, being the same lot or lots of land conveyed to J.N. Williams and M.A. Williams, by Mrs. Fannie E. Goodlett by two separate deeds, bearing date of Aug. 1st, 1910 and Jan. 6th, 1911 respectively.
