(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. B. Parker for and during his natural life,

all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina near Greenville City, on Endel Street and being the same tract of land conveyed to W. H. Balentine by Cleveland and Williams on April 27th. 1914, the deed to which is recorded in R. M. C. office for said County and State, Vol. 25, page 101, and the same tract of land conveyed to Olive A. Peace by W. H. Balentine on the 25th day of October, 1916, see Vol. 21, page 280 R. M. C. office, and being the same tract of land conveyed by Olive A. Peace to Ellie Oglesby on the 4th day of December, 1918, see R. M. C. office.
