KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Walter R. Smith of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
Sixty-six hundred DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Richard F. Watson (Lawyer) of Greenville, S.C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Richard F. Watson, All that piece, parcel or tract of land on the south side of the

Southern Railway, in Chick Springs Township and on Marrowbone Creek, waters of Enoree River in the County and State aforesaid, containing Thirty acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake 25 feet from center of right of way, on south side, of said Southern Railway; thence S. 88 W. 27.39 to A. Tenner's line; thence S. 5 W. 10.33 to a stone; thence N. 84 1/2 E. 22.08 to a stone; thence S. 10 E. to Marrowbone branch; thence S. 83 E. 7.00 to sweet-gum; thence down said branch S. 72-3/4 E. 3.40 to bridge; thence N. 19 E. 2.00; thence N. 22 1/2 W. 90 links; thence N. 72-3/4 W. 3.90 stone; thence N. 4 W. 10.01 to beginning of corner, bounded by lands now or formerly of Jos. Edwards Est., Wm. Barton, Chas. Wynn and others. Also, all that piece, parcel or tract of land in Chick Springs Township, between the Southern Railway and Chick Springs Road, adjoining lands of H.M.
