on the west side of the Augusta Road and known and designated as lots #3 and #19 on a plat of a survey made by R.E. Dalton, C.E., August 1922, with slight revision as to depth of said lots, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on West side of Augusta Road two hundred feet from the north-west corner of the G.E. Cunningham property and running thence S. 62-27 W. 604.4 feet to an iron pin on east side of a forty foot street; thence N. 26-27 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots #19 and 18; thence N. 62-27 E. 603.2 to a stake on the west side of Augusta Road, joint corner of lots #3 and #4; thence S. 27-29 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

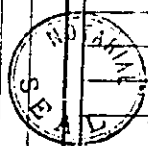
