

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, E. P. Mc Knight and J. L. Hunt, both of Greenville, S.C.

did on the 13th day of September, 1923, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Hunt-McKnight Inc.
THIRD: That the principal place of business is West Greenville, S.C.
FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is Printing and engraving.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Three Thousand (\$3000.00) Dollars, payable in money or property.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Thirty (30) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter XLVII, Article I, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1912, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Daily News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. Parker Dove, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

WHEREAS, J. J. Lawton, Hartsville, S.C., and B. C. Heers and H. J. Haysworth, of Greenville, S.C.

did on the 17th day of September, 1923, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Greenville Cotton Oil Mill, Inc.
THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S.C.
FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to own and operate oil mills and ginneries, to manufacture and sell oil meal and other products of cotton seed oil of which the products of cotton seed form a part, to manufacture, mix and sell fertilizer, to own, buy and sell real estate, and to do all other acts and things which a corporation is authorized to do under the laws of the State of South Carolina.
