

State of South Carolina } Agreement to open Street.

The undersigned hereby agree mutually and in consideration of the mutual benefits and advantages to open up, as soon as convenient, or upon formal demand of either party, a street fifty (50) feet wide, commencing at the Augusta Road and extending to the Old Augusta Road, cost of opening street not to exceed \$75 to M. W. Jones, the center of said street being the common line between the lots of land belonging to the undersigned, one of which was conveyed to Manning W. Jones on January 31, 1923, by deed recorded in P. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., Vol. 87, page 289, and the other this day executed and delivered to Ben Cleveland & L. A. Mills by C. P. Simmons and J. B. Moran, which is to be recorded in said P. M. C. office; and to this we hereby bind our heirs and assigns.
