Beginning: At an iron pin on Hunt
street northern corner of lot No. 150 running
thence with line of lot No. 150 in a easterly
direction 84 feet to a stake on a 10 foot
alley; Thence with line of said alley in
a northerly direction 50 feet to an iron
pin on said alley; Thence in a westerly
direction to an iron pin on Hunt street;
thence along Hunt street 50 feet to the
beginning corner; The points on the
