(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Godfrey Webster, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kanatelah", and situated on the north side of Oregon Street, and known as lot #9 of Block "C" on plat of the said property recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County in Plat Book "F", at pages 66 - 67. The said lot has the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the north side of said Oregon Street (sixty feet west of the corner of Mitchell Street) and running thence along Oregon Street S. 63-30 W. sixty feet to stake at corner of lot #8; thence along said lot N. 26-30 W. one hundred and sixty-five feet to stake at corner of lot #18; thence along said lot N. 63-30 E. sixty feet to stake at corner of lot #10; thence along said lot S. 26-30 E. one hundred and sixty-five feet to the beginning corner on Oregon Street.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
