NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Bassett, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said J. G. Snipes,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

J. G. Snipes and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate and being in Darlington Township, State and County aforesaid, known as tract No. 9 of the lands sold in the case of A. H. Howard vs. J. W. Sullivan, et al, and bid in by J. G. McSwain who received deed for same from J. W. Kelly, Master on January 10, 1907, recorded in Vol. 1545, page 236, R. M. C. Office Greenville County, the same being that tract of land conveyed to J. D. F. Smith by E. A. Almerson by his deed dated December 9, 1915 and recorded in Vol. 159, page 33, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County containing 69 1/2 acres, more or less, according to a plat of Survey made by G. P. Miller, D. d. April 1901. Reference to said plat being made for further description.
