This instrument witnesseth that I, the undersigned, do convey to the person or persons named and described below, all that place, parcel or tract of land lying and being, situated in Glassy Mountain Township and County and State aforesaid on the head waters of Morgans Creek and Green River, containing two hundred acres, more or less with twenty-five or thirty acres thereto, adjoining lands of Arthur Howard on the south, Joshua Lindsey on the east, James H. Jeff Howard on the north and by lands of Rachel Lindsey, husband and Malinda Howard on the west. For further particulars see plat made by J. B. Norman, September 15, 1880.

Said plat covers about two hundred acres, which is conveyed by this deed and this alternative or thirty acres conveyed to Rachel Lindsey and Malinda Howard about 1864. Said tract being the same lot of land conveyed by P. W. Lindsey to V. E. Gridlock.

Also one other place or parcel of land, lying and being situated in Glassy Mountain Township and County and State aforesaid, containing Ninety acres on the branch waters of Green Creek - Glassy Creek. Beginning on a rock above Isaac Bellows new ground; thence north to Glassy Creek; thence down Glassy Creek to a dogwood; thence south with Levi Tarris land to a pine; thence south east to a chestnut oak-Levi Tarris corner; thence south to a Chestnut oak, Green Creek to a rock; thence southwest to a black oak; thence northwest to a chestnut oak; thence along a range of rocks to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said George Steghees, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I, George Steghees, do hereby bind

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said George Steghees, his

heirs and assigns, against

all and singular suits, actions, causes and demands which may be lawfully brought against the said premises, during the time of my life, and

afterwards, by my heirs, executors and administrators, and by the said George Steghees, his

heir, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
