the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **J. P. Rosamond,** and **his** heirs and assigns forever, all **that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid, on the corner of Buncombe and Duncan Streets, fronting one hundred three feet on Buncombe Street and running back one hundred four feet on Duncan Street, and being part of the same lot of land conveyed to Louisa Gilreath by S. J. Deuthit, Master, June 7, 1880, said deed recorded in Book KK, page 693, R. M. S. Office for Greenville County, less a small lot on Duncan Street heretofore, conveyed to Helen Gilreath and same lot devised to Willie May Gilreath and Helen Lula Gilreath by the last will of Louise Gilreath, deceased.**
