KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

We, Anthony Hart, W. W. Hart, Ella Hart Mitchell, Annie Hart, Odorn, Nora Hart Odorn, Effie Hart Davis, and D. W. Hart

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Five thousand Two hundred and no/100 — — — DOLLARS, \$5200.00 — — —

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by E. E. Odorn

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

E. E. Odorn, all of our right title and interest in and to the following pieces, parcels, and tracts of land, to-wit:
Tract no. 1. All that tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County, Highland Township in the State aforesaid on the South side of Jordan Road, being the same tract of land which was conveyed to Peter P. Mills by Wm. A. Hughes, deed bearing date 30th day of May, 1868, recorded in Book C. C., page 368, and described in said deed as follows: commencing at a post oak in the cross road near P. Hill's home, running thence down new Jordan road to stake in east direction; thence S. 10 3/4 N. 28.50 Ch. to red oak; thence N. 8 1/4 W. 23.50 Ch. to a pine on new Factory road; thence with new Factory Road to the beginning corner.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to Anthony Hart by Lela L. Mills and W. J. Mitchell by their deed dated November 20, 1909, and recorded in deeds Volume 5, page 123, less, however, a tract containing Seventeen and 87/100 (17.87) acres, which was conveyed by Anthony Hart to W. W. Hart by deed dated November 26, 1907, and recorded in deeds Volume 42, at page 195, reference thereto being made for a more complete description.
Tract no. 2. All that tract or piece or parcel of land lying on the South side of Jordan Road, Highland Township, adjoining lands of P. A. Odorn, A. J. Stokes, A. Hart and containing eleven and one half (11 1/2) acres, more or less. Being the same tract of land conveyed by John P. Hill to Anthony Hart by deed dated January 5, 1906, and recorded in deeds Volume 33, page 157.

Tract no. 3. All that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Highland Township:
Beginning at a stone on John P. Hill's old line near Habits barn and runs near South to S. L. Mills corner, an East corner with the same degrees as the line between S. L. Mills and A. Hart from the old Factory Road to the old Dickey line to a rock corner, A. J. Stokes near a cotton house thence with A. J. Stokes and P. A. Odorn line to a stone on P. A. Odorn's line, thence N. W. with Hill's line on the same land A. Hart bought of John P. Hill to the beginning corner.

Being a part of the land A. J. Stokes bought of L. L. Cannon bounded by lands of P. A. Odorn, A. J. Stokes and S. L. Mills, containing ten (10) acres, more or less. Being the same lot of land conveyed to A. Hart by A. J. Stokes deed dated January 11, 1916, and recorded in deeds Volume
