in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Johnnie Hitt, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Greenville County about two miles west of the Court House, on property known as "Summit View", and known as lot #15, in Block "C", on the west side of Redstone Street; as shown by plat of same recorded in office R. M. C. in said County, in plat book "A", page 75, fronting on Redstone Street 50 feet, and being one hundred and fifty feet deep, and being bounded by lands of Hitt and Julia D. Charles. See R. M. C. deed book 127, page 402.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, West of the city of Greenville, known as lot #15, Block "C" on plat of "Summit View", see plat book "A", at page 75, said lot having a frontage of fifty feet on Redstone Street, with a depth of one hundred and fifty feet to an alley, in parallel lines.
