in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said J. T. Gault and Mrs. Annie Knight Gault, their heirs and assigns forever

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Jones or Holland's Mill Road just outside the incorporate limits of the town of Fountain Inn, containing thirteen and forty four hundredths (13.44) acres, more or less, and being the identical land conveyed by J. T. Gault to J. M. Gault by deed recorded in Vol. 116, page 376, with the exception of that portion sold by the executors of J. M. Gault to W. Shell Thackston containing 1.55 acres, more or less, on the East side of the public road. Said land being bound on the North by lands of Ebe Gault, on the East by lands now or formerly of J. M. Gault; on the South by lands of W. Shell Thackston and on the West by lands now or formerly of P. A. Green, Ruth Cox Curry, et al.
