in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said Slater Manufacturing Company,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County State of South Carolina, Beginning at an iron pin on the line between Slater Manufacturing Company and the property of J. Norwood Cleveland and heirs of R. Mays Cleveland and running thence with the present line of the Slater property S. 43-50 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-55 E. 138.75 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-17 W. 400 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 37-30 W. 338 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1.4 acres, more or less.
