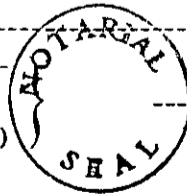

relinquish unto the within named Arthur H. Mackey, his

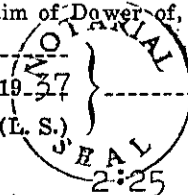
