(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Fred Whitehead;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State aforesaid,  
County of Greenville, in a subdivision known as Piedmont Park and according to a plat of same by  
C. M. Furman, Jr. duly recorded, having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a  
pin on the South side of Pine Avenue, joint corner of lot #17 and #18, and running thence with  
Pine Avenue, S. 83-22 E. 120' to an iron pin; thence S. 6-38 W. 231' to an iron pin; thence N.  
83-22 E. 120' to an iron pin; thence N. 6-38 E. 231' to the beginning corner and according to  
aforementioned plat, being designated as lot No. 18 of said subdivision and being the same lot  
of land as conveyed to me, the said Ruth B. Whitehead by J. W. Norwood by his deed April 19th,  
1933 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 169, page 185.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State  
and County aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Pine Avenue, corner of property now owned by Ruth B. Whitehead and  
running thence along Pine Avenue, S. 81-20 E. 179 feet to a stake on Cherry St.; thence along  
said street, S. 7-15 W. 238 feet to a stake; thence N. 82-45 179 feet to an iron pin, corner of  
property now owned by Ruth B. Whitehead; thence N. 7-10 E. 231 feet, more or less to the point  
and place of beginning corner. This being the same lot of land as conveyed to me, the said Ruth
