RELEASE

Beginning on iron pin on right-of-way of National Highway #29; thence N.28 W.103.2 feet to iron pin; thence S. 72 W. 52 feet to iron pin on Gallivant line; thence S.28 E. 103.2 feet to right-of-way of National Highway; thence along right-of-way of said highway, 92 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 1/8 of an acre more or less, according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman, February 5, 1934.
