(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Lucia Smith Prince

All my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-third interest, of,  
in and to: all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, known as lot No. 8 in block Book E, as shown on plat of property  
of Melville Land Company, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book at  
page 59.

Said lot is the same conveyed to Eula M. Smith by Melville Land Company by deed dated  
June 3, 1902; recorded in R. M. C. office said County in deed book HHH, page 466.

The said Eula M. Smith departed this life intestate on the 11th day of October, 1911,  
leaving as her sole heirs at law and distributees, her husband, R. D. Smith and her three  
children, Ethel, Lucile and Lucia Smith.

R. D. Smith subsequently deeded his undivided one-third interest to the said three  
children by deed recorded R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 114 page 9, dated  
August 15th, 1927.

This deed conveys to Lucia Smith Prince the undivided one-third interest belonging to  
Ethel Smith Jones.
