the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. W. Davis:

All of my undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Chick Springs Township, fronting on a Road running along the East side of Paris Mountain leading off the Buckhorn Road and has the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake in the center of said Road running along the East side of Paris Mountain, and nine hundred feet from the intersection of said Road with the Buckhorn Road; thence along said Road N. 54-50 W. 100 feet along the center of said Road; thence S. 35-10 W. 716 feet to a stake line of W.
