CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

WHEREAS, Rev. Francis M. Royall and Mary S. Royall, Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of an association for religious work, organization to be known as "Rev. Francis M. Royall and Mary S. Royall"

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 4th day of June, A. D. 1936, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, That said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is Rev. Francis M. Royall and Mary S. Royall

THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH. The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is religious work among Israel in Palestine, The Near East, Europe and the United States of America.

Blackwell, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter ~~158~~ 158, Article III, Code of 1932 and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter ~~158~~ 158, Article III, Sections 8158-8159 and 8160, Code of 1932 and Acts amendatory thereto.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and 36 and in the one hundred and ~~xxx~~ sixtieth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
