We, the undersigned,

being the incorporators and agents appointed by the members of the North Greenville Farmers' Cooperative, organized for the purposes hereinafter set forth, do affirm and declare that the said association desires to be incorporated under Article 4 of the 1932 Code of Civil Laws of the State of South Carolina, for the purpose of promotion, fostering and encouraging the intelligent and orderly marketing of agricultural products through cooperation and elimination of speculation and waste, and to make the distribution of agricultural products as direct as can be efficiently done between producer and consumer, and to stabilize the marketing problems of agricultural products.

That, after due notice was given by publication thereof in the Greer Citizen, a newspaper in Greenville County, South Carolina, a meeting of the members of said association was held on the 31st day of October, 1938, at which meeting all of the members were present in person or by proxy. That resolutions were offered and unanimously adopted, which provided that:

(a) The name of the corporation shall be North Greenville Farmers' Cooperative.

(b) The purpose for which said corporation is formed is to engage in any activity in connection with the marketing or selling of the agricultural products of its members, or with the harvesting, preserving, drying, processing, canning, packing, storing, handling, shipping or utilization thereof, or the manufacturing or marketing of the by-products thereof, or in connection with the manufacturing, selling or supplying to its members of machinery, equipment, or supplies, or in the financing of the above enumerated activities, or in any one or more of the activities specified herein.

(c) The place where its principal business will be transacted is Mountain View High School, in Greenville County, South Carolina.

(d) The term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty years.
