All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the west side of Whitehall Street, at the southwest intersection of Woodside Circle, and being described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest intersection of Whitehall street and Woodside Circle, and running thence along the line of said Whitehall street in a southerly direction, 85 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, corner of lot now or formerly belonging to J.
