(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Carl L. Gullick and Guy A. Gullick, as Executors of the Estate of M. L. Gullick, deceased,  
their successors in office, heirs and assigns forever;

All my undivided right, title and interest (the same being a one-fifth interest)  
in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 30 on plat of the property  
of Overbrook Land Company, said plat being recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in  
Plat Book "C" at page 224, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a pin on the Southern side of North Street, eighty feet from the corner  
of Spruce Street, and running thence S. 32-41 E. 236.9 feet to an iron pin on Walnut Street;  
thence S. 67.07 W. 74.5 feet to a pin on Walnut Street; thence N. 32.41 W. 240.2 feet to a pin  
on North Street; thence along said North Street N. 63.19 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner,  
being the same description as the said lot No. 30, with the exception of a strip ten (10) feet  
wide sold off the East side of said Lot No. 30 to W. R. Hale January 1, 1924, said deed being  
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "99" at page 175.

This being the same property conveyed to M. L. Gullick by Wm. E. White by deed dated  
March 1, 1927 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "126"  
at Page 79, and the interest herein conveyed being inherited by me under the will of M. L.  
Gullick filed in the Office of Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment "261", File 7.
