V. C. Cox, his heirs and assigns forever:-

That certain lot or parcel of land in Chick Springs Township, said County and State, near the town of Greer, and being a part of the Greer Plant Tract of the Victor Manufacturing Company, and having the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the public road leading from the Buncombe Road to Hollis Street, at or near the corner of R. P. Jones tract, on the opposite side of the road, and runs thence with the said road, N. 33 E. 3.16½ to corner of (formerly) C. W.
