Alys C. Hunter, her heirs and assigns, all that certain lot of land, being and lying in the town of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina: on White-horse road, and Lewis Street; and more fully described as follows to-wit:

The same being part of Lot #61---according to a sub-division made by one Earle--of the property of Looper and Yown, --the map of same having been made by R. E. Dalton, C. E. under date of May \_\_\_ A.D. 1922; ---which plat or Map is hereby referred to, and made a part hereof;

Lying and being in the intersection of "White Horse road" and the Lewis Street:

Beginning at a point in said White-Horse road, and runs thence North 11 Deg. East, 53 feet, to a stake-corner of said White-Horse road and Lewis street; thence with said Lewis street South 79° 45' West; 233 feet to a stake; thence South 10° 15' East, 50 ft.; to a stake; thence North 79° 45' East --parrallel with said Lewis street; 230 feet to a stake on said White Horse road-- the point of beginning.
