SIXTH. That they desire to be incorporated in perpetuity.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioners pray that the Secretary of State do issue to the aforesaid GREENVILLE COUNTY HOSPITAL CARE ASSOCIATION Certificate of Incorporation, with all rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities conferred by Act. No. 296, page 459 Statutes at Large for 1939, approved June 29, 1939, and Acts amendatory thereto, to provide for the incorporation of organizations having no capital stock, but desiring to be incorporated for the purposes hereinabove named.
