All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Butler Township, on the White Oak Road, northwest of Super Highway No. 29, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in State Highway No. 291 and running thence N. 83-25 W. 153 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4-30 W. 561.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 86-23 E. 346 feet to an iron pin in State Highway No. 291; thence with the center of the State Highway No. 291 in a northwesterly direction approximately 570 feet to point of beginning, containing three acres more or less and being a portion of the land formerly owned by Sellie W. Raines and conveyed to the Grantor by McAlister, Smith & Pate, Inc., in their deed dated October 6, 1938, and recorded in Volume 206, page 214, October 12, 1938.
