known and designated as Lots Nos. 65 and 66 as shown on a plat of the T. W. Dill Estate
made by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, October 1940, said plat recorded in office of the RMC for said
County and State, said lots fronting 50 feet each on the west side of the Suber road between
the Super Highway and the old Greenville-Spartanburg road about two and three quarter miles
west of the town of Greer, the north line of lot 65 running back in a westerly direction 247
feet to line of lot 70, the joint line of 65 and 66 being 252 feet, the south line of lot 66
being 258 feet, each lot being 50 feet on the rear.
