

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Conyers & Gower, Inc.,

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Thirty and no/100 (\$230.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mimie M. Cartee, her heirs and

assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the southeast side of West View Avenue near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 of Block A as shown on plat of East Highlands Estates made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K at page 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of West View Avenue, corner of Lots 26 and 27, said pin being 160 feet in a southwesterly direction from the intersection of West View Avenue and Laurens Road, and running thence with the line of Lot 27 S. 43-28 E. 88.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 27 and 28; thence with the line of Lot 28 S. 47-30 E. 88.3 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of a 5-foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with said strip S. 38-23 W. 37.2 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 25 and 26; thence with the line of Lot 25 N. 51-05 W. 175.1 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of West View Avenue; thence with West View Avenue N. 37-00 E. 54.4 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the following building restrictions:

- (1) Said property shall be used for residential purposes only.
- (2) Said property shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes or persons of African descent.
- (3) No residence shall be erected on said property costing less than \$1750.00.
- (4) The building line as shown on the recorded plat and all other restrictions shown on said plat are to be strictly adhered to.
- (5) Said property shall not be recut or subdivided so as to face in any direction other than as shown on said plat.
