HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said George Porter

All the right, title and interest of the minor Defendants, Williams Owens and Jessie Belle Owens, the same being an undivided one-thirty-second (1/32) interest each, in and to the following described real estate, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on Hammett Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 7 on a plat of Property of Estate of Clarence Goldsmith, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, June, 1929, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", page 148 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Hammett Road, joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, and running thence with line of Lot No. 8 S. 40-43 E. 110 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 16; thence with line of Lot No. 16 S. 49-17 W. 45 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 6; thence with line of Lot No. 6 N. 40-43 W. 110 feet to an iron pin on Hammett Road; thence with Hammett Road N. 49-17 E. 45 feet to the beginning corner.
