decree, **and upon receipt of \$2250.00**

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said P. C. Thompson

All the right, title and interest of the minor Defendants, Henry B. Armstrong, Shadie T. Armstrong and Dixon F. Armstrong, the same being an undivided one-fifth interest each, in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, in Ward Two of the City of Greenville on the Rowley property, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a pin on the north side of East Avenue, 103 feet, 4 inches from the intersection of McGee Street, and running thence N. 21-45 W. 155 feet to an iron pin on a ten-foot alley; thence with said alley S. 80 W. 51 feet, 8 inches, to an alley; thence with said last named alley S. 21-45 E. 155 feet to a point on East Avenue; thence with East Avenue N. 80 E. 51 feet 8 inches to the point of beginning"
