

TOGETHER with the right jointly with, but not to the exclusion of, the Grantor to exercise the easement and right conveyed by J. Norwood Cleveland and Daisy B. Cleveland to Slater Manufacturing Company by deed dated October 3rd, 1927, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 141 at page 413 for the maintenance and use of a sewer pipe line with accessories.

The grantor reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns, the right and easement in perpetuity to tie onto any of the above granted pipe lines, and particularly with sewer lines, pipes or mains leading from its mill buildings, office buildings and all other buildings now standing, or hereafter erected, on lands retained or owned by the grantor herein to tie onto and connect with the sewer pipe line running from the District boundary to the disposal plant, and thence to Saluda River, and without any charge to, or obligation upon, the grantor, to empty sewerage into said pipe line or main and into such disposal plant, and to use said disposal plant and sewer line jointly with said District, all without charge to, or obligation upon, the grantor, its successors or assigns.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee ~~to~~ hereinabove named, and its Successors ~~and assigns~~ and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee ~~(x)~~ hereinabove named, and its Successors ~~and assigns~~ and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
