

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT I, Roy P. Eison, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint Mrs. Martha S. Eison my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit.

TO ASK, demand, sue for, recover, collect and receive all such sums of money, debt, dues, accounts, legacies, bequests, interests, dividends, annuities and demands whatsoever, as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, payable, or belonging to me; and have; use and take all lawful ways and means in my name, or otherwise, for the recovery thereof, by legal process, and to compromise and agree for the same, and grant acquittances or other sufficient discharges for the same, for me and in my name; to bargain, contract, agree for, purchase, receive and take lands, tenements; hereiditaments, and accept the seisin and possession of all lands, and all deeds, and other assurances in law therefor; and to lease, lot, demise, bargain, sell, remise, release, convey, mortgage and hypothecate lands, tenements and hereditaments, upon such terms and conditions, and under such covenants as (she) shall think fit. Also to bargain and agree for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise, choses in action, and other property in possession or in action; and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business of what nature and kind soever; and also, for me and in my name, and as my act and deed, to sign, seal, execute, deliver and acknowledge such deeds, deeds of trust, covenants, indentures, agreements, mortgages, hypothecations, bottomries, charter parties, bills of lading, bills, bonds, notes receipts, evidences of debts, releases and satisfaction of mortgages, judgment and other debts and other such instruments in writing, of whatever kind and nature, as may be necessary or proper in the premises.

To endorse, for the purpose of securing cash therefor or deposit thereof, any and all checks, drafts, promissory notes, certificates of deposit or other orders or instruments for the payment of money; to execute and deliver checks, drafts, promissory notes, certificates of deposit or other orders or instruments in my name and stead; and upon receipt or moneys, checks or other evidences of indebtedness for any reason paid or delivered my said Attorney, to pay or deposit the same in my name, or otherwise with any bank, broker, or other agent, and to draw out such money from time to time and to apply the same to any purpose that (she) may so desire.

GIVING AND GRANTING unto Mrs. Martha S. Eison, said Attorney, full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever that (she) may deem necessary or desirable to be done for, and in my behalf, as fully as to the same extent, and to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if personally present, her by ratifying and confirming any all acts that my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

To execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household effects as authorized by law and Army Regulations, and to receive, indorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States.
