Church, their successors in office, forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township.....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
about two miles Southeast from Mountain View School, lying on the South side of the <sup>FEARNS</sup> May's Bridge  
Road, being bounded on the North by other lands of the Gum Springs Pentacostal Hiliness Church,  
on the East, South and West by other lands of myself, and being a part of the same tract of land  
conveyed to me this day by deed from Joe Hall, Executor of the Last will and Teastament of L. K.  
Hall, deceased, and having the following courses and distances; to-wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin, being the present corner Southwest corner of the original
