(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
H. Daniel Forrester and George D. Forrester and their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
containing Fifty (50) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of L. A. Forrester and others, and  
designated as Tract No. 2 of the Henry Forrester lands according to survey by James K. Dickson,  
Surveyor, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone, corner of Lot No. 1, and running thence S. 2 1/4 W. 3.20 to a stone,  
red oak gone; thence S. 3/4 W. 12.97 to stone; thence N. 88 E. 33.64 to a stone; thence N. 12 W.  
14.06 to stone; thence S. 77 1/2 W. 1.00 to stone; thence N. 12 W. 2.18 to stone; thence S. 88 W. 28.54  
to the beginning corner.
