All that piece, parcel or lot of land in.....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the town of Greer, on the south side of Fairview Avenue, and being designated as Lot #13 in Block 1, and the portion of Lot #14 adjoining lot #13 in Block 1, on plat recorded in Plat Book A, at page 299, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Lot No. 13, beginning at a point on Fairview Avenue, corner of lot #12, and runs thence with said Avenue to the corner of lot No. 14, a distance of 56 feet; thence along the line of #14, to the corner of Lots 14-17-18, a distance of 178.4 feet; thence along the line of #18 to the negro Church Property, a distance of 55 feet; thence along the line of #12, a distance of 151.3 feet to the beginning property, and being all of No. 13 in Block 1 on said plat.

Also, that portion of lot #14 in Block 1, adjoining lot #13, and beginning at the P. P. Paris corner on Fairview Avenue, and runs thence with this Avenue, East 16 1/2 feet; thence S. 7 W. 185 feet to point on line of #18, on corner with balance of lot #14; thence N. 82-35 W. 16 1/2 to corner of P. P. Paris, lot #13; thence along this line, N. 7-25 E. 178 feet to the beginning corner, and being a part of said lot #14, adjoining to lot #13.

The first lot above described being that conveyed to P. P. Paris by Bessie McMakin by deed recorded in Vol. 73, page 361; and the last one conveyed to P. P. Paris by S. G. Bruce and Miss M. E. Hadden by deed recorded in Vol. 157, page 23.

The interest hereby conveyed being that owned by me as the widow of the late P. P. Paris, the grantee and myself constituting the sole heirs of the said P. P. Paris, deceased.
