

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, John Henry Sowers, a legal resident of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, (Rank Captain, Army Serial No. 0318013, in the service of the Army of the United States, and temporarily residing at Camp Gruber, Oklahoma) have made, constituted, and appointed by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint Bobbe Eskew Sowers of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney for me, and in my name, place and stead, and to my use

To act in, manage, and conduct all my estate, and all my affairs:

To do and perform any and all acts and things which could lawfully be done by me in connection with or respect to any and all property, real, personal, and mixed wherever situate, which I now own or may hereafter acquire;

To sign my name to and execute on my behalf, all contracts, transfers, deeds, conveyances, liens, assignments, agreements, bonds, stocks, checks, drafts, releases receipts, and instruments or writings of any nature;

To sue, make and settle all claims and demands and receive payments therefor; and to sue, prosecute, defend, and appear for me, in any action in law or in equity or any other proceedings;

To execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipping of house-hold effects as authorized by law and Army Regulations, and to receive, indorse, as collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; giving my said attorney full power to do everything whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises, as fully as I could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or his/her substitute, shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue hereof.

The above specially enumerated powers are in aid and exemplification of the full, complete, and general power herein granted and not in limitation or definite thereof.
