M. A. Jordan and Mae Jordan and their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

lying on both sides of topsoil road leading form O'Neal to Berry's Mill, containing Sixty and three eights (60 3/8) Acres, more or less, bounded on the North by lands of Paul Barton and W. W. Edwards, on the East by lands of C. O. Berry, on the South by lands of J. O. Hightower and J. J. Bramlett, and on the West by lands of A. L. Southern, and having the following courses and distances according to a survey by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, May \_\_\_\_\_, 1943, to-wit: Beginning on Paul Barton's corner and on line of W. W. Edwards, and runs thence with Edward's line and line of A. L. Southern S. 49.30 E. 1066 feet to an iron pin in the O'Neal-Berry's Mill old road bed; thence along the O'Neal-Berry's Mill road S. 29.25 W. 535 feet to a point in said road (iron pin on southeast bank of road); thence with line of J. J. Bramlett S. 47.20 E. 710 feet to a large pine on Bramlett's line, J. O. Hightower corner; thence with Hightower's line N. 42.10 E. 687.5 feet to an iron pin, Hightower's corner; thence continuing with Hightower's line N. 56.15 E. 549 feet to point in center of new road (iron pin on south bank of road); thence along the center of said road as follows: N. 34 W. 100 feet, N. 25.15 W. 100 feet, N. 7.40 W. 800 feet, N. 25.07 W. 100 feet, N. 31.42 W. 300 feet, N. 29.38 W. 400 feet to the center of intersection of said road with the O'Neal-Berry's Mill Road; thence N. 23.45 W. 211 feet to iron pin on Paul Barton's corner; thence with Barton's line S. 45.54 W. 416.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 59 W. 1251 feet to the beginning corner.
