All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the south side of Cureton Street near the City of Greenville, being the western half of lot No. 7, as shown on plat of property of Thomas T. Goldsmith made by R. E. Dalton, C. E. in February, 1920, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 113, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

> Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Cureton Street corner of Lot No. 6, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 34-27 E. 204.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-52 E. 35 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly owned by Laura Peace Echols; thence with the line of said property approximately N. 29 W. 201.55 feet, more or less, to a stake on Cureton Street; thence with the southern side of Cureton Street, S. 58-19 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner. C. F. Putman agrees to assume and pay a certain mortgage given by E. W. Goldsmith to the Fidelity Federal Saving association of Greenville S. C. in the amount of \$3100.00 on which is a balance of \$2775.00 due on said mortgage, this being the same property conveyed to me by E. W. Goldsmith by his deed dated July 15th, 1942 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 246 at page 60.
