

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Henry Ansel Jones, do hereby name, nominate and appoint my wife, Mary Louise Jones, as my true and lawful attorney in fact and do hereby empower the said Mary Louise Jones in my name and stead to sell and convey unto such persons as she may see fit and for such price and upon such terms as she may see fit, all my right, title and interest in and to the estate of my mother, Etta Jones, consisting of 61.71 acres, of land situate in Butler Township, Greenville County, S.
