to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Flora G. Campell, her heirs and assigns:-

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being on the South-west side of Trowbridge Avenue on Paris Mountain in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina and being designated as Lots 47, 48, 49 and 50 and a triangular lot at the rear of said lots in Section A on plat of Paris Mountain Caesar's Head Development Company made by R.E. Dalton June 1925, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Trowbridge Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 50 and 51, said pin also being corner of property of Flora G. Campbell, and running thence along the line of Lot 51 due west 280 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly of Wm. H. Austin; thence with said Austin line N. 42-26 W. 418.9 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at corner of property formerly of W. C. Cleveland; thence with said Cleveland line, N. 79-0 E. 556 feet to an iron pin on southwest side of Trowbridge Avenue; thence with southwest side of Trowbridge Avenue along a curve line and running in a southwesterly direction 402 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
