The terms, "estate", "affairs", and "property", as used herein include, and shall include at all times and places and under all conditions, real, personal and mixed property of every kind and description whatsoever, and wheresoever situated, and all buildings, structures, improvements, fixtures, vehicles, appliances, accessories, furnishings, equipment, choses in action, equities, priorities, permits, rations, quotas, rights of way, mineral and oil rights, water rights, easements, licenses, future interest, reversions, remainders, and all other kinds of property or property rights whatsoever, and every interest, title, equity, tenement, hereditament, appurtenance, right, claim, demand, or action therein and thereunto appertaining, and whether said property or property rights be tangible or intangible, jointly or severally owned, or now or hereafter acquired.

This Power of Attorney shall remain in force for ten (10) years from this date.
